**1. Agenda Item: Announcements/Check-in**

- College Council seemed pleased with the WCC SLO committee update and the use of *The SLO Lane*. Thanks to B. Asmus for presenting on behalf of our committee.
- The Academic Academy is scheduled for March 15<sup>th</sup>.
- New SLO posters are being designed. There is a consideration how to brand the posters to include CLC.
- There are several surveys being developed for our District
  - Campus Climate Survey – If we use a nationally pre-created survey then we may be able to conduct this survey this semester. Otherwise the District will need to pilot and check validity for self-created instrument. There is the option to add specific questions regarding SLOs and Accreditation to this survey. IERT will be working on this.
- Fall 2015 iSLO survey data is online.

**3. Accreditation**

- Howerton and Julie Brown attended the ASCCC Accreditation Institute. Howerton shared his notes with the SLO committee.
- Discussion regarding strategies to meet the expectation of review of disaggregated data for the future standards and how to align with data already collected in student services, and program review data for official review.
- WCC is working on its ACCJC mid-term report. ART will ask for feedback from the SLO committee regarding status with the 'planning agendas' from our last full self-study.
- Data for the Annual report is being uploaded and a narrative will need to be written.
- Discussion regarding an official mapping of the GE areas. Working with curriculum committee regarding a sustainable practice of review and verification for courses in the GE patterns and ask for GE courses to have a GE specific SLO identified for GE SLO assessment needs.
- Curriculum will be reviewing and possibly revising AP4100.

***NEXT STEPS: review the planning agendas from previous Accreditation self-study and follow up on formalizing a GE plan recommendation for Senate.***

**4. SLO Development issues**

- Senecal has presented President's Cabinet with the feedback from the SLO committee regarding AUOs
- Currently no additional development issues or training needs have been brought to the committee's attention.
- The next issue of The SLO Lane will be released sometime in April. There is a plan to add a "highlight of an assessment method" (i.e. rubric creation, pre-post testing, etc.) This will also be an opportunity to communication with the campus the additional resources that we have in our College library that could assist faculty and staff with assessment needs.
